

A Free Nancy's Notions® Project Sheet for You...

Can Cooler

Add an element of fun to your next party, and keep your hands warm and dry while your beverage stays refreshingly cool. Combine fabric scraps, hook and loop tape, and straight stitching to make these quick to sew Can Coolers. Add embroidery for your own personal touch. These eye-catching yet functional accessories are perfect for parties and picnics.

SUPPLIES: (makes one wrap)

- One 2½" x 11½" strip Fabric A (center band)
- Two 1½" x 11½" strips Fabric B (upper and lower bands)
- One 4½" x 10" rectangle Quilted Iron Quick (lining)
- 3" length hook and loop tape (closure)
- Optional: embroidery designs, tear-away stabilizer, and rayon thread

(We used Amazing Designs® Summer Picnic CD. Designs #012, #013, and #014 are perfect for this project.)



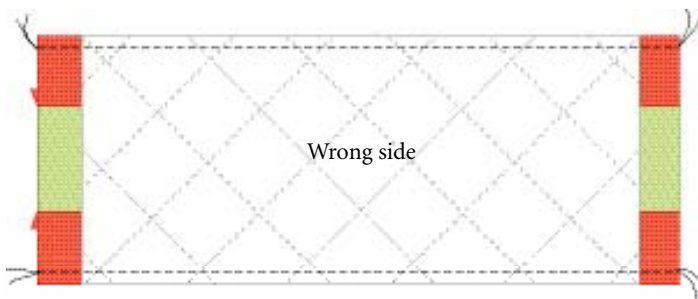
DIRECTIONS:

All seam allowances are ¼".

1. Add embroidery or appliqué embellishment to Fabric A (center band), if desired.
2. Stitch upper and lower bands of Fabric B to long edges of center band, right sides together, aligning cut edges. Press seams.



3. Line cooler with Quilted Iron Quick Fabric.
 - Meet silver side of Quilted Iron Quick to right side of fabric cooler, leaving equal amount of fabric extending beyond the ends of the Quilted Iron Quick.
 - Align long cut edges and stitch, forming a tube.



4. Turn cooler right side out. Press.
 - Hem both short ends by turning the cooler fabric under twice (toward lining) covering the cut edges of the lining. Edgestitch in place.



4. Attach 3" sections of hook and loop tape for closure.
 - Position hook side of tape on right side of can cooler along the edgestitching line. Stitch in place along all four sides of the tape.
 - Position loop side of tape on lining side of can cooler along edgestitching line. Stitch in place along all four sides of the tape.
