Fabric Fortune Cookies

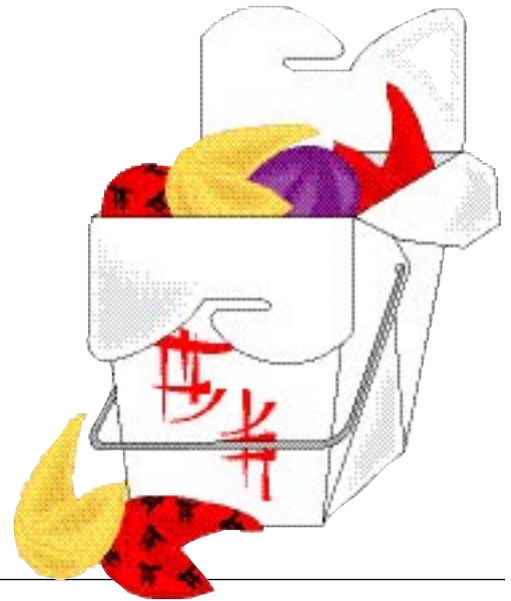
Create these fun, no-sew fortune cookies for your next party favor. Use up all of your beautiful fabric scraps to create a bowlful!

SUPPLIES:

- 5" squares of fabric (two for each cookie)
- Chopsticks or Pencils
- Steam-A-Seam 2®
- Fabric Glue
- Perfect Sew™ Spray Stabilizer

HANDY NOTIONS:

- Olfa® Rotary Circle Cutter
- 18" x 24" Olfa® Mat

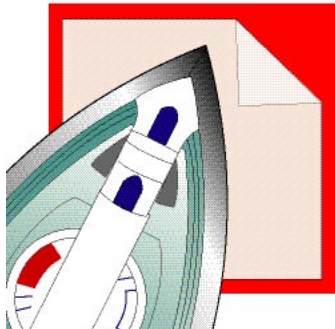


DIRECTIONS: (FOR ONE)

1. Prepare fabric.

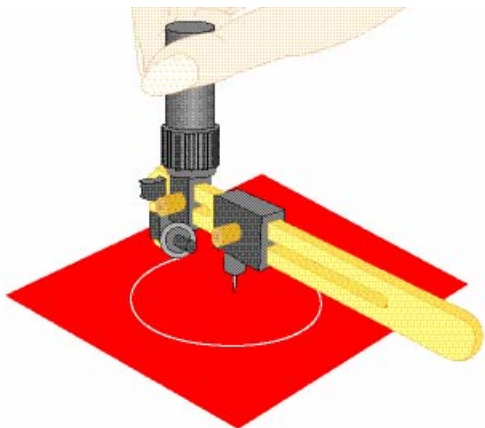
- Cut one 4½" square of Steam-A-Seam 2® fusible for every two 5" fabric squares.
- Fuse web to wrong side of one fabric square.

Note: Each side of Steam-A-Seam 2® web includes paper. To determine the correct side to fuse to the fabric, remove the paper on one of the sides to see which side the web sticks to. Center the paper with the web on it over the fabric square, with web facing the fabric. Press.

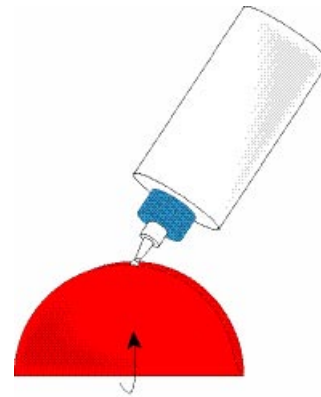


- Remove paper backing and center remaining fabric square on top of the Steam-A-Seam 2®. Fuse both layers of fabric together.

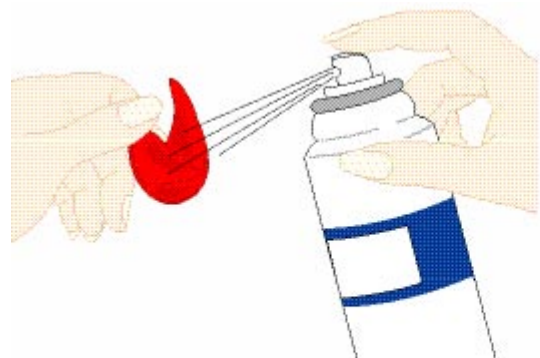
2. Cut a 3" circular "cookie" using the Olfa® Circle Cutter, following manufacturer's instructions.



3. Fold the circle in half and place a dab of fabric glue between the edge of the layers to hold them together.



- 4. Write a good luck fortune on a small slip of paper and insert it into the cookie.
- 5. Bend cookie in the middle to form a fortune cookie shape, and spray lightly with Perfect Sew™ Spray Stabilizer.



6. Insert chopsticks or pencils in outer ends to hold shape. Allow to dry.

Note: You can speed up the drying process by using a hair dryer.

7. Optional: Make or purchase a "Take-out" box to display a batch of Fabric Fortune Cookies.
