Ho! Ho! Holidays Embroidered Ornaments

Make these easy-to-embroider candy ornaments to decorate a small tree for the holidays. Create individual ornaments or stitch multiple candies on cording for a unique garland.

FINISHED SIZE: approximately 1¼" x 2" (each ornament)

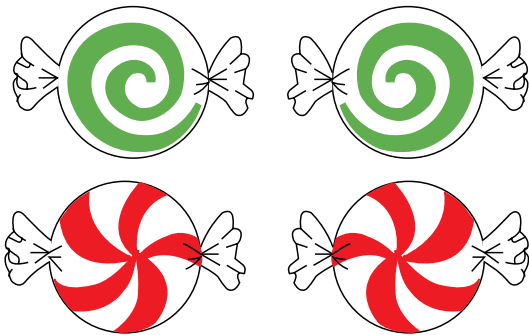
SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Stabilize It!™ Medium Nylon Cut-away Stabilizer
- Amazing Designs® Ho! Ho! Holidays CD by Sewing With Nancy® (The following designs are illustrated: Swirl [HOHO-05] and Stripe [HOHO-06]. Another design possibility is the Swiggle [HOHO-07].)
- Rayon embroidery thread (We used the following colors: White [MRE1001], Christmas Red [MRE1147], Christmas Green [MRE1051], and Black [MRE1000])
- Lightweight bobbin thread or Bobbinfil
- Matching all-purpose thread
- Cording or heavy decorative thread (4" for each ornament hanger)

DIRECTIONS:

All seam allowances are ¼".

1. Set up your machine for embroidery following manufacturer's instructions.
2. Hoop stabilizer in your largest hoop so that you can make lots of ornaments without rehooping.
3. Mirror image the designs you have chosen and save them to your machine.



Note: If you are not able to mirror designs on your embroidery machine, you may want to use software such as Edit 'N Stitch 2.0 on your computer.

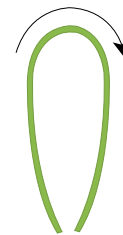
4. Embroider candy designs desired, and then embroider mirror images of each for the back sides of the ornaments.
5. Cut out ornaments from stabilizer with a very sharp scissors.
6. Complete the ornaments.



HANDY NOTIONS:

- Amazing Designs® Edit 'N Stitch 2.0
- Curved Embroidery Scissors
- Dura-steel Finny scissors
- Optional: Fabric glue

- Sandwich a candy design and its mirror image wrong sides together.
- Cut a 4" length of cording for each ornament and fold in half.



- Insert cording hanger at the top of the ornament between the layers.
- Stitch around the outside edges of the ornament to secure and catch the cording for hanging. If you prefer, the ornaments can be glued together with fabric glue.
- Optional: Cut a longer cord for garland and sandwich ornaments over cord, wrong sides together. Stitch around outside edges of ornaments, or use fabric glue to secure.
