

Autumn's Riches Table Runner Design Layout Tips

Supplies Needed:

- Amazing Designs® Autumn's Riches Embroidery Designs CD with FREE Edit Express software for resizing, color editing, and printing templates (AD-ZIE07)
- Autumn's Riches Rayon Thread Pack (ARTPK18)
- Additional Madeira Rayon Embroidery Thread Colors:
 - 1000 Black (MRE1000 or MREE1000)
 - 1001 White (MRE1001 or MREE1001)
 - 1060 Light Putty (MRE1060 or MREE1060)
 - 1065 Orange Sunrise (MRE1065 or MREE1065)
 - 1084 Ecru (MRE1084 or MREE1084)
 - 1136 Toast (MRE1136 or MREE1136)
 - 1137 Orange Yellow (MRE1137 or MREE1137)
 - 1158 Tawny Tan (MRE1158 or MREE1158)
 - 1248 Lime Green (MRE1248 or MREE1248)
 - 1257 Dark Maple (MRE1257 or MREE1257)
 - 1311 Dusty Lavender (MRE1311 or MREE1311)
 - 1358 Chestnut (MRE1358 or MREE1358)
 - 1387 Light Plum (MRE1387 or MREE1387)
- Hydro-Stick™ Tear-away Stabilizer (HTA3)
- Fabrics:
 - Four tan tone fabrics ranging from light to dark for blocks, inner border, and triangle border
 - Three brown tone fabrics ranging from medium to dark for triangle border, outer border, and binding
- Optional: Autumn's Riches Hot-fix Crystals Set (HFCARST)

Helpful Notions:

- Prewound bobbins (PB24W)
- Matching all-purpose thread
- Perfect Sew™ Spray (PSS2) or Best Press Starch Alternative (BP60031)
- Rotary cutter, mat, and ruler

Helpful Tips:

- Stabilize the block fabrics with spray starch or a starch alternative such as Perfect Sew™ Spray or Best Spray Starch Alternative.
- Prepare five interior blocks. Assemble the table runner, including the triangle border and outer border.
- All design components are pictured on the following pages. Each grouping indicates the order in which the various designs making up that grouping should be stitched. In each instance, start with background designs and work toward foreground designs. Some designs are embroidered over portions of other designs.
- For the remaining embroideries, work from left to right, stitching each portion of the design in sequence.
- Alternate sunflower design and leaves design for the triangle border.
- Use a water-activated self-adhesive stabilizer rather than hooping the table runner. Economize by using stabilizer on a roll. Instead of cutting the stabilizer to the size of the hoop, keep the stabilizer on the roll when you hoop. After embroidering the first section, carefully tear away the fabric from the stabilizer. Give the stabilizer a quick press to smooth out the wrinkles from the first hooping; then rehoop the next section of stabilizer and continue embroidering.
- Note the special instructions for stitching the Chinese lantern blooms in design #27150. After embroidering the first three colors of the design making up the stems and leaves, skip over colors 4, 5, and 6, which are the blooms. Stitch design #27160 completely, then return to design #27150 and stitch the remaining three colors of the Chinese lantern blooms.

Design Layout and Modifications

The guides on the following pages indicate which designs were used, where those designs were placed on the table runner, and how the designs were modified (resized, rotated, mirror imaged, and thread colors skipped), as well as the design stitching order. If thread colors are not listed, use the colors specified with the design.

= Mirror image horizontally

% = Percentage to resize design

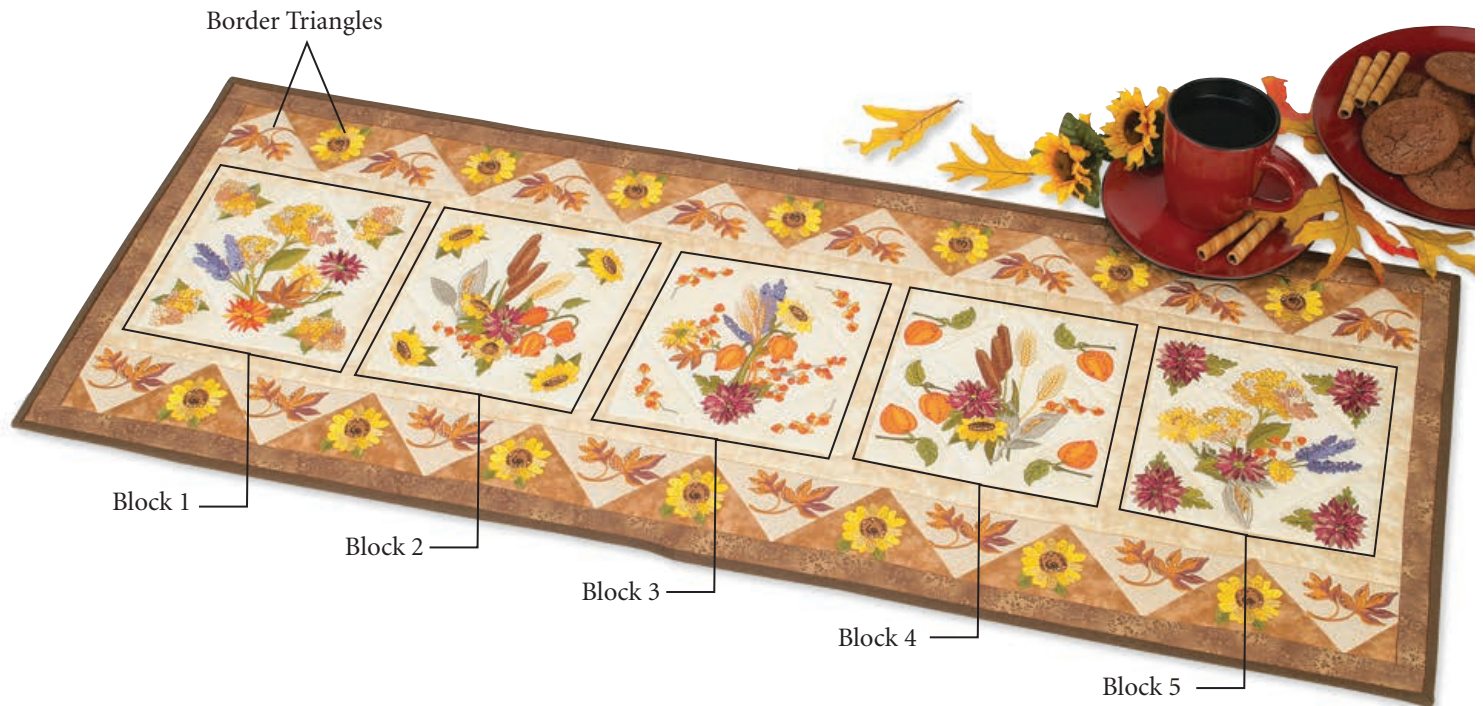


= Degrees to rotate right

Border Triangles



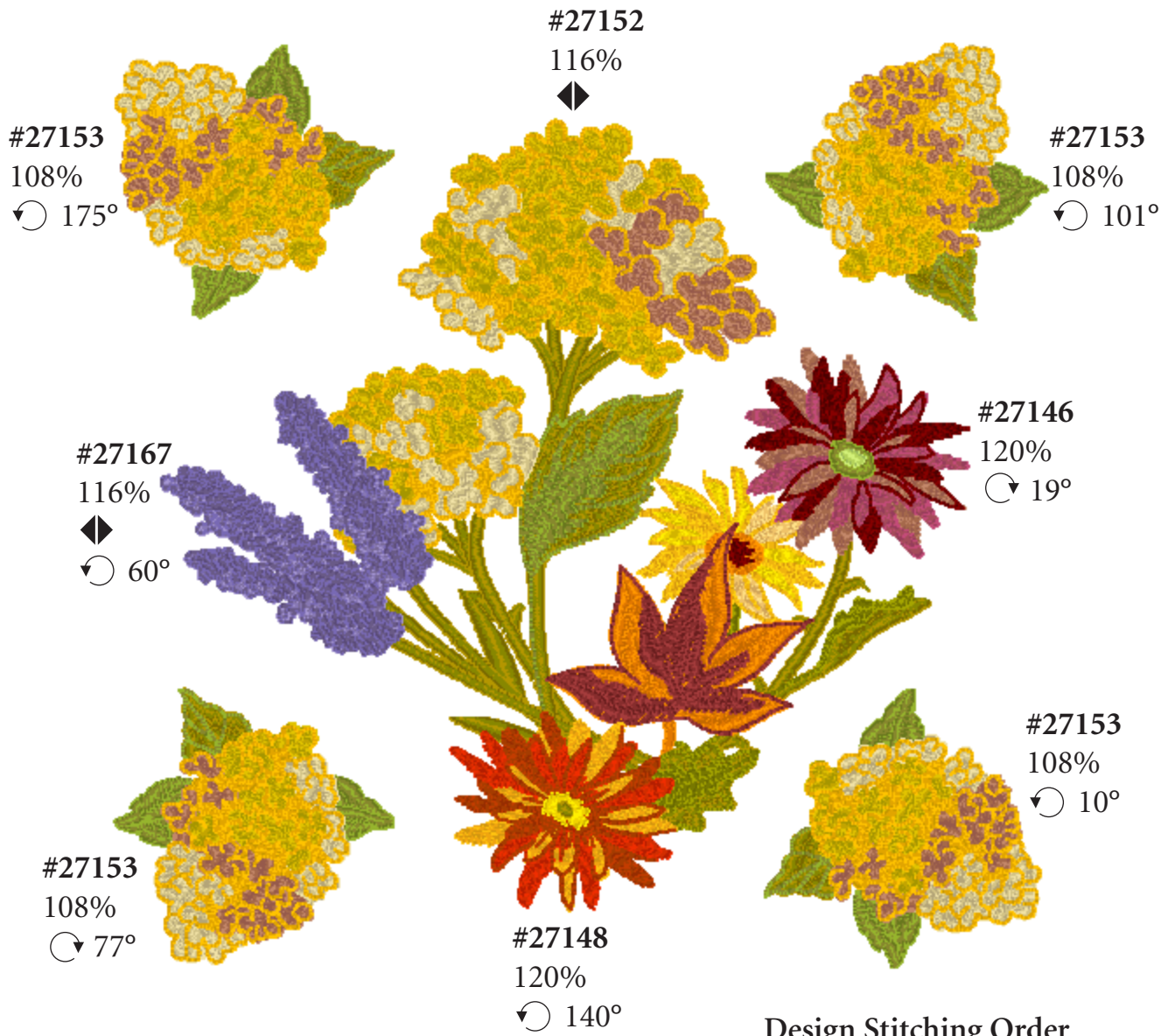

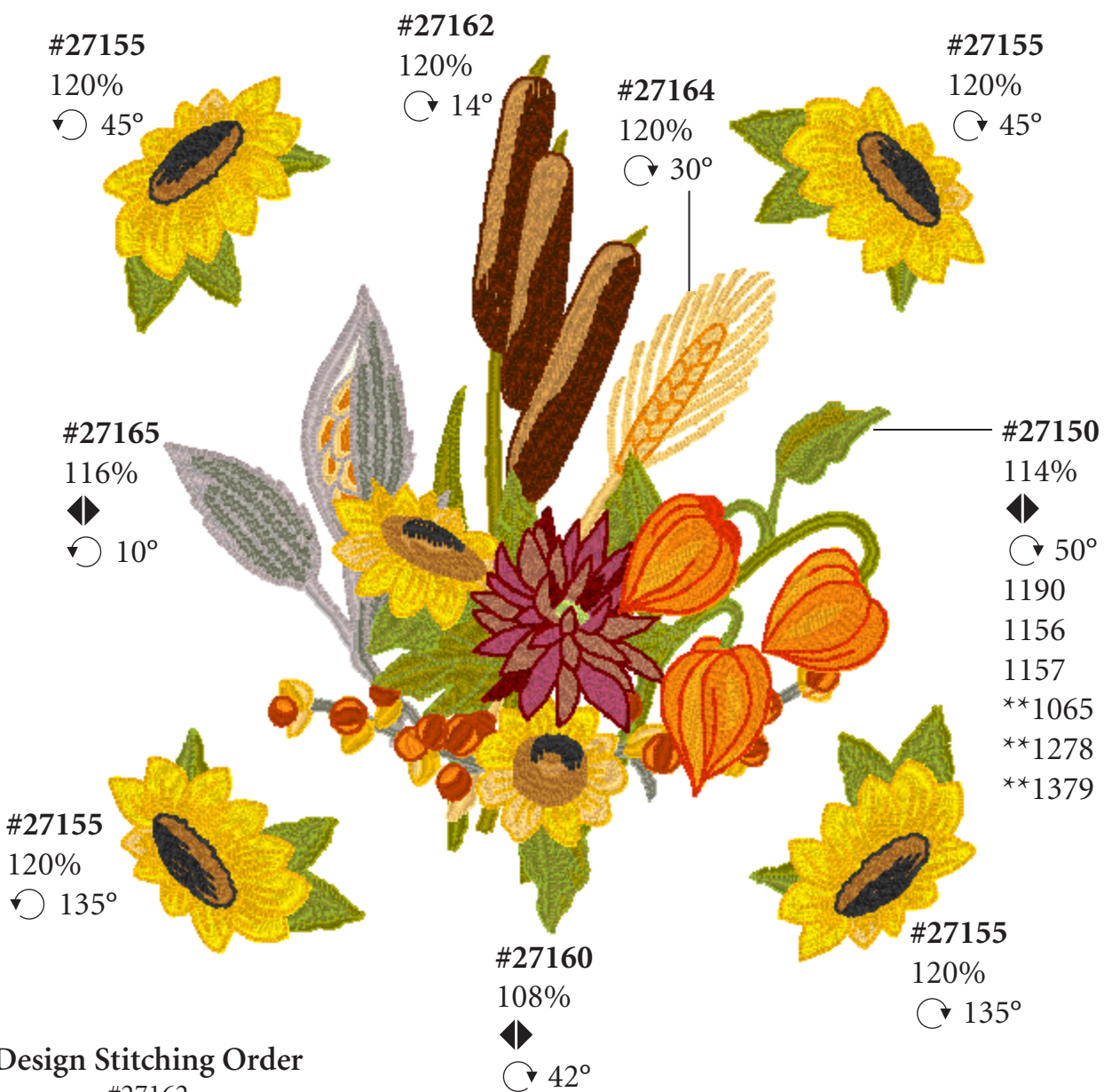

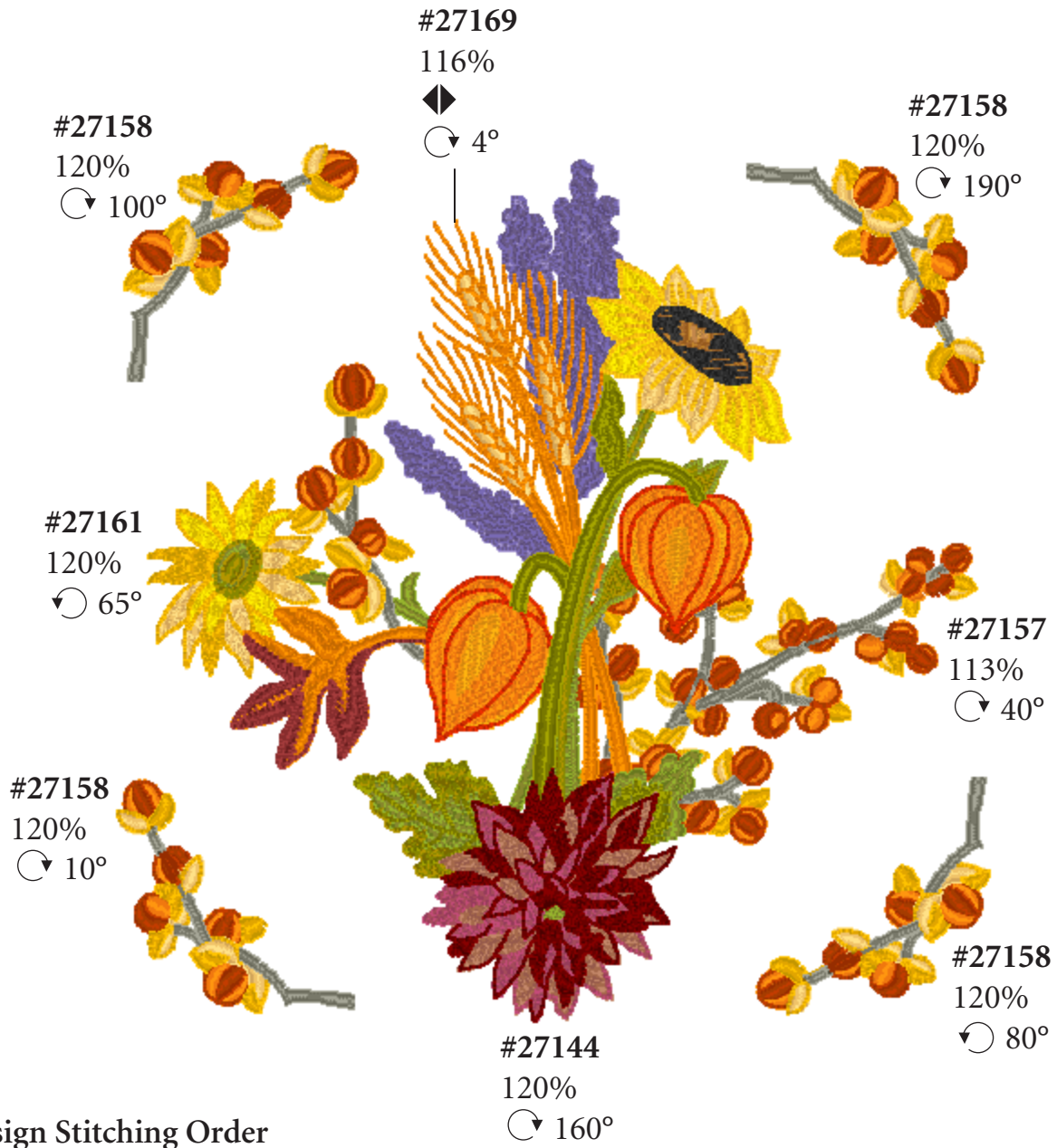

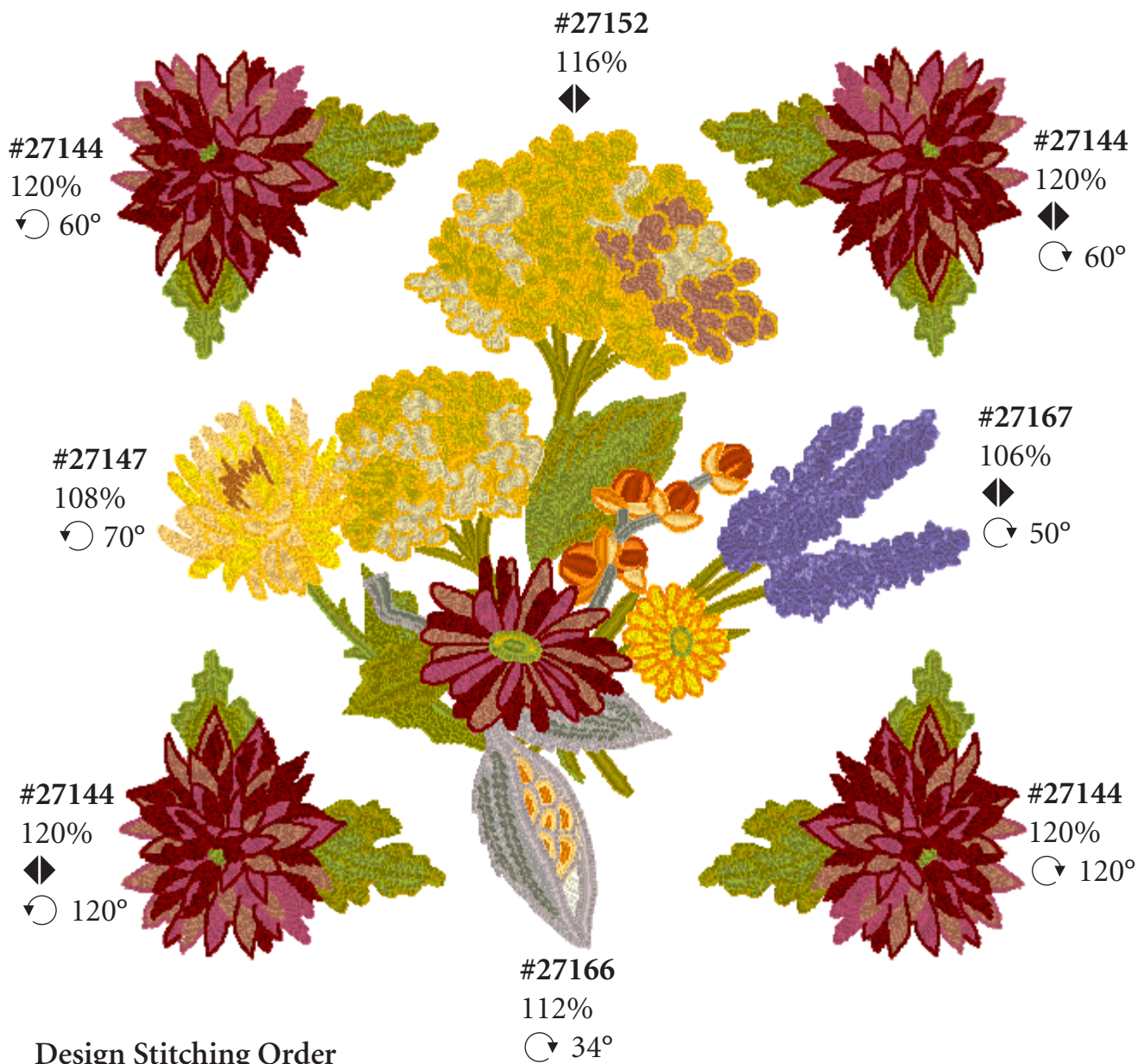
